# Fire Department Monthly Status Report

# August 28, 2025

While the fire danger in the district has stayed moderate, Elk Creek has seen a lot of lightning strikes, several of which caused fires. One of the fires, the White Hawk Fire was ignited on July 22. The fire started from a lightning strike to a Ponderosa Pine tree and quickly spread in the surrounding grass. The location was on the border of Conifer FPD and Elk Creek FPD. When we arrived, we found that there had been fire mitigation done in the area which kept the spread to a minimum.

After researching the area, the mitigation was part of a Jefferson Conservation District mitigation project from 2014. The work broke up the fuel continuity and directly led to a smaller, lower intensity fire. This is an example of how fire mitigation is important and can have direct effect on fire spread.

July also had the Elevation Celebration which is one of the larger community events. Fire Marshal Rush helped organize coverage for the event.

Elk Creek has also retained the services of CLA (CliftonLarsonAllen LLP) to assist with accounting and the transition to new accounting software. The new accounting software is the same platform but a cloud-based, updated system. We will be using CLA to assist in the transition as well as assistance on the 2026 budget. The firm will also be assisting with financial reporting.
